"Medical tourism can be very risky. Many of these foreign countries just do not have the certifying and credentialing bodies that we have here in the U.S. and you can literally be taking your life in your hands. Some of these patients come to my office upon their return with disastrous outcome looking for help repairing the damage. Sometimes there is very little that can be done. They've had nasty materials injected into their eyelids, for example, that you just can't cut out, can not dissolve.
